Acceptance of minutes

With vandalism by the children continuing to be a problem, the meeting resolved to ask teachers to speak to the children in relation to naming the culprits.

Upcoming AGM

With the next meeting of the P&C being the AGM, it was decided that the school would put forward a budget of required expenditure to the meeting under the newly formed committee in order to expedite the flow through of funds at the beginning of 2008.

Principal's Report

- ❖ Fence almost complete
- ❖ Pamela Moore and Naomi Goodchild have been recognized as Quality Teachers by the DET
- ❖ A new ESL teacher has been appointed
- ❖ Kirsty Pancraz has been appointed as relief teacher
- ❖ The school will request advice from a qualified structural engineer via the school newsletter regarding building toilets under Block D.
- ❖ The fence on Zone 4 is falling down, as a result of prior work done by the school. The cost of repair is approximately \$11,000, which will be a school expense.
- ❖ School reports are to be distributed 19 December and will include a distribution of results table.
- ❖ Anticipating 678 students next year (638 now). This will include 8 kindergarten classes.
- ❖ The school is intending to apply for a grant under the Investing In Our Schools grant programme to fund the new toilet block.

Treasurer's Report

Funds available for the end of the year are \$30,000 for restocking of the uniform shop, and \$10,000 for emergencies.

Other business

- ❖ It was requested that Maria de Caires investigate the possibility of bundling uniform items together to make it cheaper overall for parents. Janet Morgan to discuss with Maria.
- ❖ It was suggested that a sponsorship approach be adopted to allow businesses to gain a tax deduction from donating to the school. It may be possible to erect billboards along Miller Street. Luke Silcock is to investigate the possibilities.
- ❖ The proposed presentation from Melissa Smith (canteen) to be postponed until 2008.
